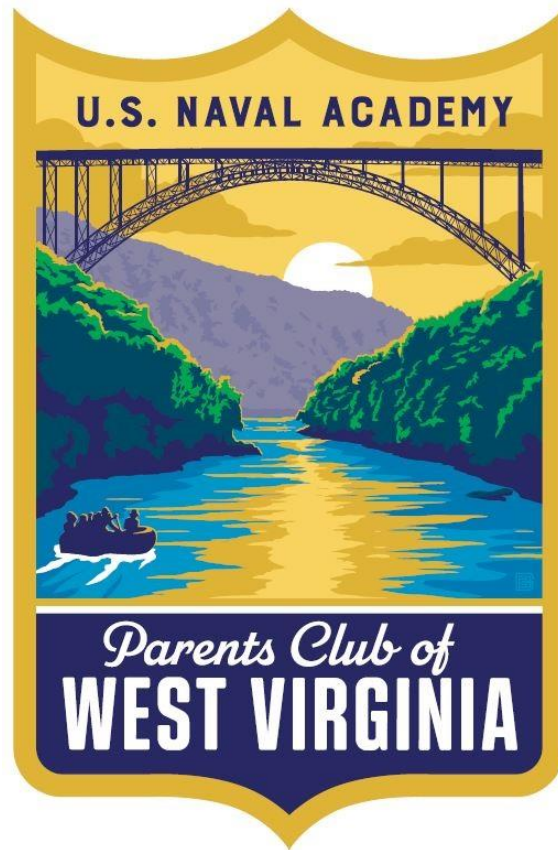

The USNA Mission

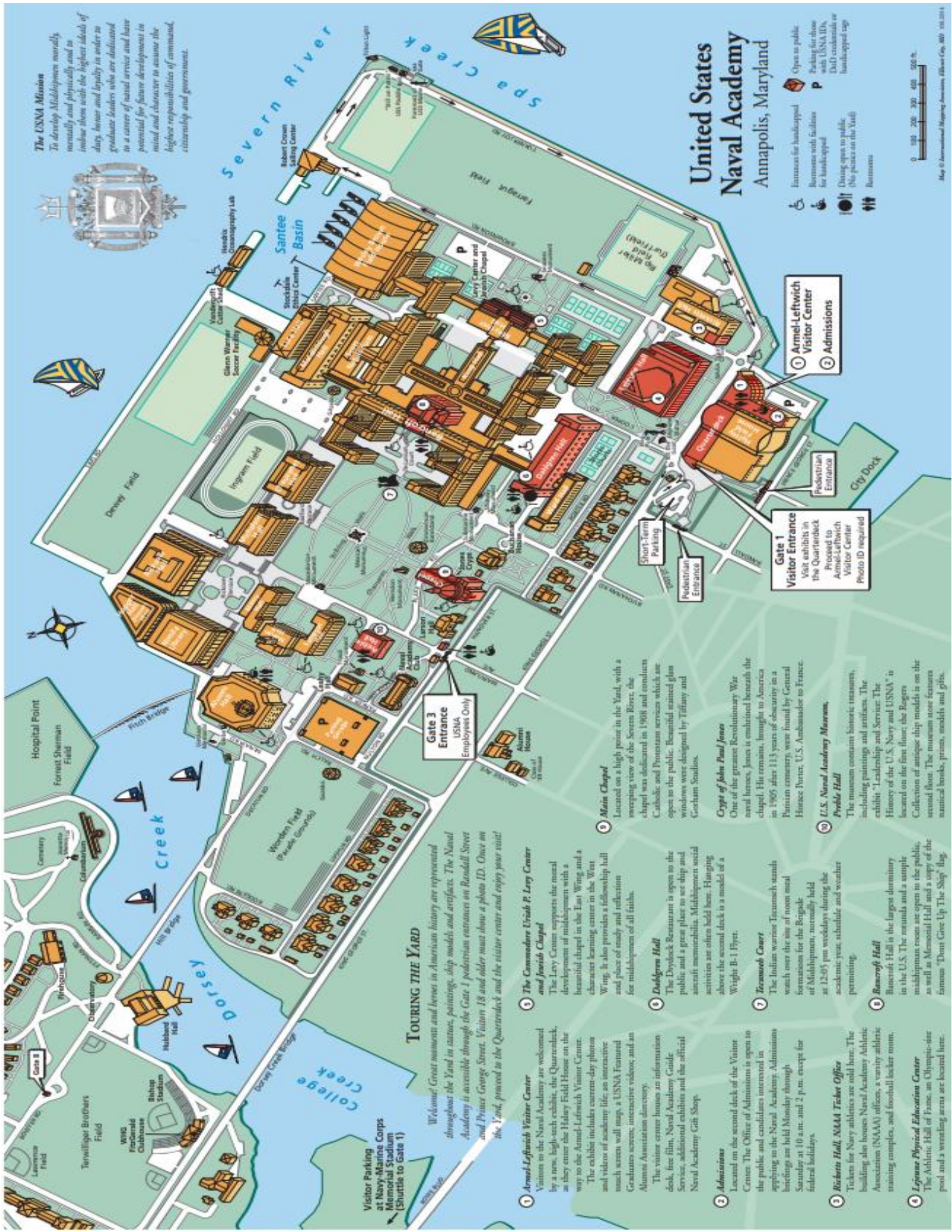

TOURING THE YARD

Wow! Great moments and heroes in American history are represented throughout the Yard in statues, paintings, ship models and artifacts. The Naval Academy is accessible through the Gate 1 pedestrian entrance on Rowdell Street and Prince George Street. Visitors 18 and older must show a photo ID. Once on the Yard, proceed to the Quarterdeck and the visitor center and enjoy your visit!

- 1 Armet-Leftwich Visitor Center**
Visitors to the Naval Academy are welcomed by a new, high-tech exhibit, the Quarterdeck, as they enter the Halley Field House on the way to the Armet-Leftwich Visitor Center. The exhibit includes current-day photos and videos of academy life; an interactive touch screen wall map; a USNA Featured Alumni Association directory. The visitor center houses an information desk, free film, Naval Academy Guide Service, additional exhibits and the official Naval Academy Gift Shop.
- 2 Admissions**
Located on the second deck of the Visitor Center, the Office of Admissions is open to the public and candidates interested in applying to the Naval Academy. Admissions briefings are held Monday through Saturday at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. except for federal holidays.
- 3 Richards Hall, NAAAF Ticket Office**
Tickets for Navy athletics are sold here. The building also houses Naval Academy Athletic Association (NAAA) offices, a variety of athletic training supplies, and football locker rooms.
- 4 Lejeune Physical Education Center**
The Athletic Hall of Fame, an Olympic-size pool and a wrestling arena are located here.
- 5 The Commodore Uriah P. Levy Center and Jarvis Chapel**
The Levy Center supports the moral development of midshipmen with a beautiful chapel in the East Wing and a character learning center in the West Wing. It also provides a fellowship hall and place of study and reflection for midshipmen of all faiths.
- 6 Dahlgren Hall**
The Dahlgren Restaurant is open to the public and a great place to see ship and aircraft memorabilia. Midshipment social activities are often held here. Hanging above the second deck is a model of a Wright B-1 Flyer.
- 7 Termowich Court**
The Italian warrior Termowich stands watch over the site of noon meal formations for the Brigade of Midshipment, normally held at 12:05 pm weekdays during the academic year; schedule and weather permitting.
- 8 Bancroft Hall**
Bancroft Hall is the largest dormitory in the U.S. The cottages and a sample midshipment room are open to the public, as well as Memorial Hall and a copy of the famous "Don't Give Up The Ship" flag.
- 9 U.S. Naval Academy Museum, Probble Hall**
The museum contains historic treasures, including paintings and artifacts. The exhibit "Leadership and Service: The History of the U.S. Navy and USNA" is located on the first floor; the Rogers Collection of antique ship models is on the second floor. The museum also features nautical books, prints, models and globes.
- 10 U.S. Naval Academy Museum, Probble Hall**

9 Main Chapel
Located on a high point in the Yard, with a sweeping view of the Severn River, the chapel was dedicated in 1908 and contains Catholic and Protestant services which are open to the public. Beautiful stained glass windows were designed by Tiffany and Goethals Studios.

Crayer of John Paul Jones
One of the greatest Revolutionary War naval heroes, Jones is enshrined beneath the chapel. His remains, brought to America in 1805 after 113 years of obscurity in a Parisian cemetery, were found by General Horace Burtner, U.S. Ambassador to France.

Parking on the Yard

If you possess a military ID (active, retired, dependent), CAC, or DBIDS credential (with driving privileges, from the USNA), you are allowed to drive on the Yard.



Directions from Route 50/301 (East or West) to Gate 1

Take Exit 24 Rowe Boulevard
Stay in the right lane toward Annapolis
After the exit, move to the left lane and continue straight until you reach the 2nd traffic light
Turn left onto Taylor Avenue
Continue straight on Taylor Avenue
At the Firehouse, bear right onto Route 450 (Annapolis Street)
Stay in the right lane
Turn right at the traffic light onto King George Street
Proceed to the end of King George Street until you see Gate 1 - United States Naval Academy

Directions from Route 50/301 (East or West) to Gate 8

Take Exit 24 Rowe Boulevard
Stay in the right lane toward Annapolis
After the exit, move to the left lane and continue straight until you reach the 2nd traffic light
Turn left onto Taylor Avenue
Continue straight on Taylor Avenue
At the Firehouse, bear right onto Route 450 (Annapolis Street)
Move to the left lane
Keep straight through the traffic light
At the next traffic light, bear right onto Bowyer Road
Keep straight to Gate 8
